ACADEMIC YEAR 2018/9 – Please see the website calendar for term dates as well as the reverse of this newsletter. We endeavour to send a newsletter home at the start of every term/month, updating dates as well as sharing children's learning. BREAKFAST CLUB – From September our Breakfast Club is available in the dining room from 8am for just £3 a session. A selection of breakfast items will be available along with a range of activities. Access to the dining room will be through the front school gate. Thank you to those people who have already completed booking forms and booked places – we're looking forward to seeing your children at 8am next term. Children will be able to go out onto playground at 8:40am, supervised by a member of staff.

Registration forms should be completed before using the Breakfast Club. Copies have emailed to parents and are also available in the office/school website, along with a pre-booking form and further information.

*Please be reminded that for those children not attending Breakfast Club the school day starts at 9a.m. Children should not arrive at school before 8:40am as no adult supervision is outside before this time. The front gate by the tennis court will be open from 8:40 until 9:10.

YEAR 3 DINNERS - From September children who are currently in Year 2 (moving to Year 3) will need to pay for school dinners (£2.20 a day to Tracy. Cheques made payable to Aldborough Primary School.)

MORNING READING – From 8:40 – 9:00am we are continuing to invite children in Classes 1, 2 and 3 (Reception – Year 3) into the Learning Street to read/share books with their parents/carers. This is a great opportunity to enjoy a story or two, creating a calm, relaxing start to the school day. As space in the Learning Street is limited and noise levels need to be kept to a minimum, please be reminded that older siblings should not be in the Learning Street. (This is also the case with children who are off school due to

illness.) Parents/carers are very welcome to use the Parent Waiting Area or large Cloakroom should the weather be inclement.

PE KIT – Please ensure that children return to school with a white t-short, plain dark shorts and a change of outdoor trainers. These should be in a small drawstring bag (large rucksacks fall off pegs!)

PARKING –Unfortunately, due a small number of inconsiderate drivers, access for other road users was severely restricted on Monday afternoon. Our neighbours were unable to access their properties and the emergency services wouldn't have been unable to get through. (The school had intended to open the overflow car park, however this was blocked by parked cars.)

Please park sensibly and think of the safety of others at all times.
